

- → 1 monitor engineer
- → 1 light enginner with his/her crew

PLANNING

- → Stage setup requires 30 minutes
- → Soundcheck requires 90 minutes

- 1 x Neumann KM 184 (violin)
- 1 active DI (Radial J48) for tenor violin pickup
- 1 DPA 4061 with violin clip and with XLR adapter (DAD6001)
- 1x 1SM58 for presentation (Clément Janinet)
- 1x chairs without armrest type orchestra chair
- 2 mic stands without boom for attaching violin stand

Bruno Ducret - Cello

- Neumann U87 (cello)
- 1x DPA 4099 with cello clip and with XLR adapter (DAD6001)
- 1x SM58 for Bruno Ducret vocals
- 1x adjustable piano stool with 4 legs (for cello board attachment)

Elodie Pasquier - Clarinet in C and Bass Clarinet

- 2 x AKG C414 ULS/XLS for Bb clarinet and Bass clarinet
- 1x stand Bass Clarinet
- 1x chairs without armrest type orchestra chair

WEDGES

- 3x wedges (12 inches) on 3 independant circuits

LIGHT

Dims light on stage

SOUND

- → The music is acoustic and quite quiet, and thus the PA must provide lots of dynamics with the lowest background noise possible.
- → The music have to be suivie dynamics
- \rightarrow For tenor violin, prefer the pickup line (DI) in the mix (80%) instead of the DPA 4061 (20%)
- → There are a lot of double basslines played by the violin tenor and the cello or by the tenor violin and the bass clarinett, please make sure the levels are balanced
- → The music requires some reverb **but not to much**
- → Elodie Pasquier (clarinets) needs some reverb on clarinet in her wedge **but not to** much
- → Clément janinet (Violins) needs some reverb on the violin in his wedge (not on the tenor violin line DI)
